

# APPLYING MCSL VINYL Instructions

## SMALL MARKINGS

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1. Roughly cut around the insignia, position in place on the model and place a piece of masking tape on one edge to create a hinge effect.



2. Apply a fine spray of glass cleaner to the painted surface and hand wipe the excess off leaving the surface slightly wet.



3. Lift the insignia and remove the backing paper, hand apply the insignia to the surface using a plastic card (or similar squeegee). Starting from the tape hinge, smooth down the insignia while working any excess fluid out.



4. Let dry, by placing the model in the sun a couple of hours or sitting overnight, then gently remove the cover paper and then the excess vinyl that surrounds the actual marking.  
NEVER remove cover paper or excess vinyl by pulling it 90 degrees from the surface, always pull it back over itself.

## LARGE MARKINGS

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1. position in place and apply a piece of masking tape through the middle and across the entire insignia, either horizontal or vertical depending on the size and shape of the insignia and the contour you're applying it on.



2. Lift one half of the insignia back to the tape. Spray glass cleaner and wipe away excess. Next cut away the backing paper and using a plastic card starting from the tape and working towards the edge, gently smooth the insignia in place.



3. Remove the masking tape. Pick up the remaining half and spray glass cleaner then peel away the remaining half of the backing paper and gently work the insignia in place starting at the middle and moving towards the outside edge.



4. Let dry a couple of hours and gently remove the cover paper, then the excess vinyl that surrounds the actual marking.
